Criteria for a graduate assistantship:

- Graduate assistantships are awarded to students who are fully admitted, without provisions, to graduate degree programs.
- To retain a graduate assistantship, the student must maintain academic eligibility and may not be on academic probation.
- Non-degree students may not hold graduate assistantships.
- Students enrolled for student teaching are ineligible to serve as a graduate assistant that semester.
- Students must enroll for their Employment and Wage Agreement to be processed.
