Title: Assistant Professor of History

Major Responsibilities:

- Teach undergraduate and graduate courses in Asian history
- Teach introductory world history surveys and other courses in the University's general education program
- Advise and mentor undergraduate students
- Continue productive research and scholarly activities
- Participate in professional service activities for the department, college and university

Qualifications:

- Ph.D. in history or Asian studies required for appointment at the assistant professor level
- Significant training and experience in target areas
- Evidence of teaching excellence at the college level and a strong commitment to student learning and development
- Evidence of scholarly activity and potential for research
- Ability to teach courses on the Islamic world a plus

Employment conditions: A nine-month, full-time, tenure track appointment. Option of summer employment if funds are available. If the successful candidate is ABD at the start of employment, the appointment will be a non-tenure track position as instructor. Salary dependent upon qualifications.

Position availability: August 16, 2010

Application Deadline: December 1, 2009. Applications received after the deadline will be considered if an acceptable candidate has not been found. Electronic applications are strongly preferred.

 - c) Statement of teaching interests and philosophy
 - d) Curriculum vitae
