

WINTHROP UNIVERSITY ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP TERMS & CONDITIONS

Fall 2021 and Spring 2022

1. This scholarship offer supersedes any scholarship offer previously sent by the Office of Admissions.
2. Scholarship recipients are required to enroll full-time each semester (12 or more credit hours) to be eligible to receive the scholarship and/or out-of-state tuition waiver.
3. Scholarships awarded to incoming freshmen are available for up to four years (8 terms total) or graduation, whichever comes first. Students must maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress and not have earned an undergraduate degree to remain eligible.
4. Scholarships awarded to incoming transfer students are available for up to three years (6 terms total) or graduation, whichever comes first. Students must maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress and not have earned an undergraduate degree to remain eligible.
5. Winthrop reserves the right to cancel Winthrop awards if tuition is covered by another source.
6. Winthrop reserves the right to adjust your scholarship due to withdrawing during a semester or for reductions in tuition, room and board, or other institutional fees.
7. Incoming freshmen who are South Carolina residents and are awarded a South Carolina HOPE or LIFE Scholarship based upon their GPA and class rank at the end of the junior year will be reviewed for confirmation of their eligibility after a final high school transcript is received. The initial award may be adjusted or removed based upon the student's final credentials.
8. Incoming transfer students must submit a final high school transcript to be reviewed for a South Carolina LIFE Scholarship.
9. Recipients of the South Carolina HOPE, LIFE or Palmetto Fellows scholarship are required to be determined in-state residents by the Office of Admissions and be enrolled full-time each semester (12 or more credit hours). 10. The Office of Financial Aid reserves the right to adjust a student's award package as necessary to comply with federal, state, and institutional regulations and to ensure the total award package does not exceed the cost of attendance. The out-of-state grant/waiver from all Winthrop sources cannot exceed the out-of-state portion of tuition (\$14,330 in 2020-21).
11. Renewal requirements for Winthrop scholarships awarded by other departments are determined by those awarding departments. Contact the awarding department for further details.
