- Interim President Hynd announced this month that the university is preparing for a traditional start to the fall semester. This will include an increase in in-person classes, in-person extracurricular activities and on-campus residency.
- The Rock Hill Coca-Cola Bottling Company Building and adjacent lots located next to campus will be transformed into "The Perch." This 22,000+ square foot, two-story building on the corner of Cherry Road and Oakland Avenue will house a mix of restaurant, retail and office space for the Rock Hill and Winthrop community.
- Winthrop was once again named a Voter Friendly Campus - one of only four in South Carolina. Through political events, civic lessons and voter registration days, Winthrop achieved this title for a third year.
