Earn an Associate of Arts from Central Piedmont Community College, and transfer to Winthrop University to earn your Bachelor of Science in educational studies- physical education teacher education. The educational studies program prepares undergraduate students to be effective community leaders, and educators. The physical education concentration includes courses in adventure leadership, teaching games, fitness activity courses, and more. While this degree does not provide an opportunity for teacher certification, it could be a pathway to the Master of Arts in Teaching (M.A.T.) degree for students who eventually want to earn certification at the graduate level.
