Admission Requirements

- 1. The online Graduate School application with the non-refundable application fee.
- Official transcript(s) from all institutions attended for undergraduate and graduate coursework. Transcripts must be sent directly to Winthrop's Graduate School office from the issuing institution(s). We cannot accept transcripts (even sealed, official transcripts) from individuals.
- 3. An undergraduate GPA of 3.0.
- 4. Submit an official score of either:
- The General Test of the GRE. Preferred scores are 151 on the verbal reasoning section and 153 on the quantitative section.

OR

- The Miller Analogies Test. Preferred score is 392.
- 5. Applicants to the M.A.T. degree in Spanish or French must also complete the following requirements:
- The South Carolina passing score on the PRAXIS and evidence of having the ACTFL Oral Proficiency Interview.
 It is recommended that applicants show proficiency at the advanced low level. Graduate coursework will not be focused directly on continued language learning.

Application Deadline

- July 15 for fall semester
- December 1 for spring semester
- May 15 for summer session
