Alessia Cara to Perform Oct. 4 at Winthrop Coliseum

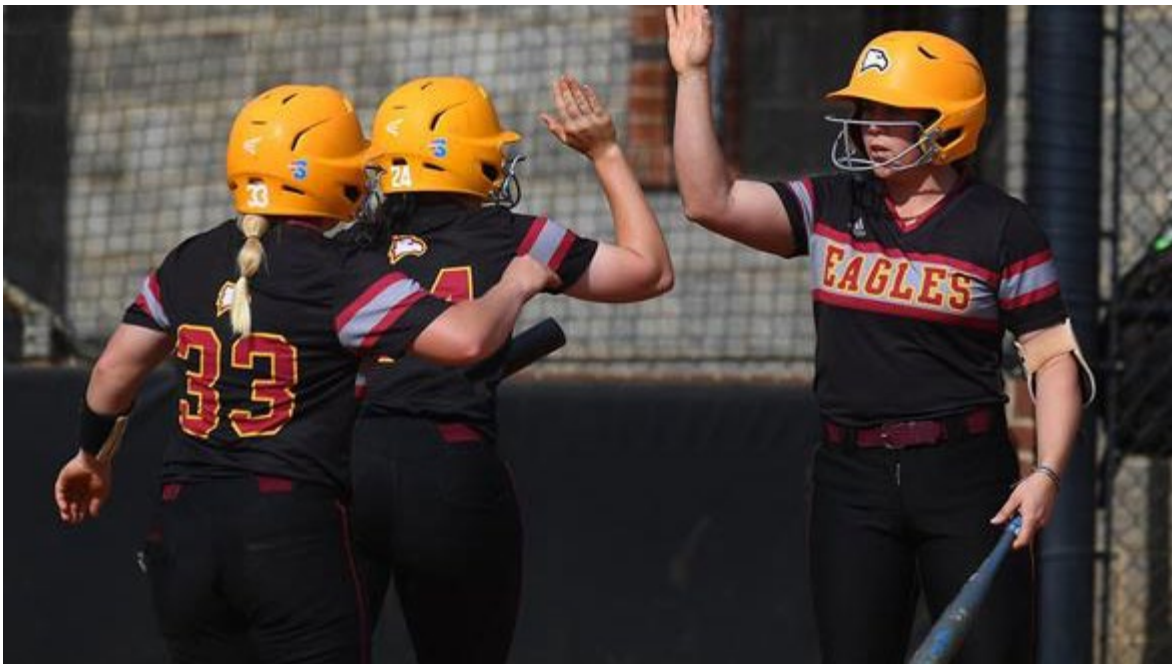

Over 70 Percent of Student-Athletes Earn Spot on Big South Presidential Honor Roll

To be named to the Presidential Honor Roll, student-athletes must maintain a grade point average of 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale) or better for the academic year.
