Winthrop Receives \$920K as Part of SC INBRE Grant

Winthrop has received funding to support biomedical research and infrastructure in South Carolina. The university is part of the fourth consecutive grant of \$18.9 million to the South Carolina IDeA Networks of Biomedical Research Excellence (SC INBRE). Winthrop, which received \$920,000 from the grant, has been a part of the network from its 2005 inception and has provided more than 450 research experiences for Winthrop undergraduates and prepared more than 130 students to pursue doctoral degrees in biomedical sciences.
