application process & requirements

Applicants should **currently** be enrolled in 10th, 11th or 12th grade in high school (who will be rising juniors, seniors or graduates in the summer of 2019). A complete Pre-University application form, \$50 non-refundable application fee, and a 250-word personal essay about your reasons for wanting to attend are required. A letter of recommendation from a teacher or guidance counselor is recommended, but **not** required for admission. We do **not** require a portfolio or audition for attending Pre-University.

Note: all attendees will be required to provide proof of their own medical coverage.
