PROGRAM OPPORTUNITY

We are extremely pleased to offer this 4-week shadowing experience at our Prisma Health Midland Richland campus.

Open to highly motivated undergraduate, rising senior premed students who do not already have an acceptance to another medical school.

This program was created 20 years ago to help empower undergraduate students with the knowledge to plan for a career in medicine. It is our hope that this shadowing experience will increase student's desire to attend USC School of Medicine—Columbia and to become a practicing physician.

Paramount to this program is the student's ability to participate in all of the dates for training and shadowing. It is also important that students have the ability to clearly understand and adhere to the rules and regulations required to “shadow” on USCSOM-C/Prisma Health Midland campus. PROGRAM SPECIFICS

During the duration of the program, students rotate weekly among four of the following areas within the USC School of Medicine—Columbia: **Family and Preventive Medicine, Internal Medicine, Obstetrics and Gynecology, Pediatrics, Psychiatry and Surgery.** Within each department, students have exposure to various aspects of the clinical arena, including procedures, patient interaction, and medical education.

Each department will provide students with a detailed schedule for their specific rotation. Students will typically be shadowing from 8am–12pm and 1:30–5pm. During the week with surgery, students will be shadowing from approximately 7:45am–3pm.

Orientation for the program will be on Monday, June 2nd at 9:00am. Lunch will be provided and then students will go to the Simulation Lab for a tour and demonstration.

On the last day of the program, students will meet for an evaluation and photo session along with certificate presentation.
