

COMMUNITY-BASED LEARNING MINOR

NEW IN FALL 2016!

The minor in **Community-based Learning (CBLN)** is designed for students exploring learning theory or educational settings in a way that complements a degree program. For instance, individuals interested in exploring learning in non-traditional educational settings such as museums, galleries, parks, and similar might consider this minor. Please note that this minor DOES NOT lead to teacher certification or licensure.

The Community-based Learning Minor consists of at least 15 credits that must include EDUC101 and EDUC200, 6 credits of approved coursework above 299, and electives selected from the list of approved coursework. At least two designators* beyond EDUC must be included in the electives (see list below).
