1. Unless stated otherwise, a single course **may not** be used for more than one General Education requirement or in a major and a minor.
2. All Arts and Sciences majors require a minimum of 40 hours in courses numbered above 299.
3. Attendance at 3 cultural events is required for each 20 hours completed at Winthrop.
4. Designators that differ only for the purpose of theory and application will be considered the same designator.

5. Complete WRIT 101, HMXP 102, and CRTW 201 with a C- or better by 75 hours.
6. Complete and pass Praxis II before admission.
7. Students must have a GPA of at least 2.75 at graduation.
8. EDUC 200 may also meet 3 hours of Social Science for General Education.
