- Unless stated otherwise, a single course **may not** be used for more than one General Education requirement or in a major and a minor.
- All Arts and Sciences majors require a minimum of 40 hours in courses numbered above 299.
- Attendance at three cultural events is required for each 20 hours completed in residence at Winthrop.
- May apply 6 additional FREN hours beyond major requirements toward 120 hr requirement.**
- Designators that differ only for the purpose of theory and application will be considered the same designator.

- Complete WRIT 101, HMPX 102, and CRTW 201 with a C- or better by 75 hours.
- Apply to graduate program in fall of last year.
- Complete and pass Praxis II before admission.
- Completion of the ACTFL Oral Proficiency Interview with a rating of advanced low or higher is expected before admission.
- EDUC 200 may also meet 3 hours of Social Science for General Education.
