 4. No more than 39 hours in ENGL may be applied to the 120-hour requirement.
 5. Designators that differ only for the purpose of theory and application are considered the same designator.
 6. Complete WRIT 101, HMPX 102, and CRTW 201 with a C- or better by 75 hours.
 7. Complete and pass Praxis II before admission.
 8. EDCO 200 may also meet 3 hours of Social Science for General Education.
