- Unless stated otherwise, a single course may not be used for more than one General Education requirement or in a major and a minor.
  - All Arts and Sciences majors require a minimum of 40 hours in courses numbered above 299.
  - Attendance at three cultural events is required for each 20 hours completed in residence at Winthrop. Note exceptions in the undergraduate catalog.
  - Designators that differ only for the purpose of theory and application will be considered the same designator.
  - Students should complete WRIT 101, HMXP 102 and CRTW 201 with a C- or better early in their academic careers.

    - \_\_\_\_\_ Complete and pass Praxis content area before admission to Teacher Education.
  - It is highly recommended that applicants to the MAT Accelerated have a C- or better in all Core Courses.
  - A grade of C or better is required in all EDCO and READ courses in the Educational Studies minor. Students may not S/U these courses. SCST 390 requires a C- or better.
