- 4. May apply 6 additional SPAN hours beyond major requirements toward 120 hour requirement.
- Designators that differ only for the purpose of theory and application will be considered the same designator.
- Students should complete WRIT 101, HMXP 102 and CRTW 201 with a C- or better early in their academic careers.
- 7. Apply to graduate program in fall of last year.
- 8. Complete and pass Praxis II before admission.
- Completion of the ACTFL Oral Proficiency Interview with a rating of advanced low or higher is expected before admission.
- 10. EDCO 200 may also meet 3 hours of Social Science for General Education.
