NOTES

1. Unless stated otherwise, a single course **may not** be used for more than one General Education requirement or in a major and a minor.
2. All Arts and Sciences majors require a minimum of 40 hours in courses numbered above 299.
3. Attendance at three cultural events is required for each 20 hours completed in residence at Winthrop.
- 4. May apply 6 additional FREN hours beyond major requirements toward 120 hr requirement.**
5. Designators that differ only for the purpose of theory and application will be considered the same designator.

6. Students should complete WRIT 101, HMXP 102 and CRTW 201 with a C- or better early in their academic careers.
7. Apply to graduate program in fall of last year.
8. Complete and pass Praxis II before admission.
9. Completion of the ACTFL Oral Proficiency Interview with a rating of advanced low or higher is expected before admission.
10. EDCO 200 may also meet 3 hours of Social Science for General Education.
