2. All Arts and Sciences majors require a minimum of 39 hours in courses numbered above 299.

4. Designators that differ only for the purpose of theory and application will be considered the same designator.
5. Students should complete WRIT 101, HMPX 102 and CRTW 201 with a C- or better early in their academic careers.

7. Applicants for the MAT Accelerated must have C- in all of the Core Requirements and HIST 211, 212, and two world histories (HIST 111, HIST 112, HIST 113).
8. A grade of C or better is required in all EDCO and READ courses in the Educational Studies Minor. Students may not S/U these courses. SCST 590 requires a C- or better.
9. Students should take SCST 590 for graduate credit. To do this complete the Intent to Pursue an Accelerated Graduate Program and the UG Taking Graduate Credit Request.
