- All Arts and Sciences majors require a minimum of 39 hours in courses numbered above 299.
- Attendance at three cultural events is required for each 20 hours completed in residence at Winthrop. Note exceptions in the undergraduate catalog.
- Designators that differ only for the purpose of theory and application will be considered the same designator.
- Students should complete WRIT 101, HMXP 102 and CRTW 201 with a C- or better early in their academic careers.
- Completion of the ACTFL Oral Proficiency Interview with a minimum score of intermediate high is required for graduation.
