1. Unless stated otherwise, a single course **may not** be used for more than one General Education requirement or in a major or minor.
 2. All Arts and Sciences majors require a minimum of 40 hours in courses numbered above 299.
 3. Attendance at three cultural events is required for each 20 hours completed in residence at Winthrop.
 4. **No more than 39 hours in ENGL may be applied to the 120-hour requirement.**
 5. Designators that differ only for the purpose of theory and application are considered the same designator.
 6. Complete WRIT 101, HMPX 102, and CRTW 201 with a C- or better by 75 hours.
 7. Complete and pass Praxis II before admission.
 8. EDCO 200 may also meet 3 hours of Social Science for General Education.
