- ³ **ELECTIVES** are courses that do not meet specific degree requirements, but are needed to meet the graduation requirement of 120 hours. Electives can include courses for an additional concentration or minor.
- ⁴ **Courses in BOLD** are only offered in the specified semester. Ex. DIFD 415 is only offered in the Fall.
