Alternative Spring Break (ASB) is a week-long immersive service and learning experience. Through meaningful action, reflection, and education, volunteers engage in direct service and explore a critical social issue in their host community or region. Volunteers have a chance to learn about the context of the issue their team will address, explore the culture and history of the area, and participate in pre-departure education and training programs while building leadership skills and developing strong relationships with their team. Each trip will be led by a trained student leader, in addition to a faculty/staff member from Winthrop University. Applications will be considered according to space availability.

There will be two different ASB Trips.

- Richmond, Virginia: Join the fun and travel to the capital of Virginia. Our ASB team will partner with Side by Side VA to aid them in their mission in creating supportive communities for the LGBTQ+ youth. Also, they will work alongside project: HOMES, completing small home improvement projects for families that "improve lives by improving homes". This trip offers the opportunity to have an enriching experience, meet new people, get outside of your comfort zone, and serve others. The focus of this trip is LGBTQ youth support and affordable housing.
- Louisville, Kentucky: Journey to the largest city in Kentucky, right along the Ohio River. Louisville, Kentucky has been aiding refugees since 1975, after the Vietnam War. Our ASB tam will partner with Catholic Charities and the Salvation Army to provide services that help refugees and immigrants transition into their new lives. Projects may include sorting donations used for refugee resettlement, assisting refugee and immigrant gardeners at their plots, assisting in a food bank/soup kitchen, working in ESL classrooms, and more. This trip offers the opportunity to serve while gaining a better awareness on how global issues impact people all around us. The focus of this trip is refugee and immigrant support.

## **Trip Details:**

Each trip will cost \$299.00 - \$202.00; this covers meals at the site, transportation, housing and some extracurricular activities for the week.

- Free time is scheduled for participants to sightsee and relax on all ASB experiences. We suggest bringing along a little extra spending cash.
- o Students must provide bedding (sheets, pillows, and blankets), toiletries, and towels.
- A Winthrop official will accompany all trips.
- ASB experiences are drug and alcohol free at ALL times. This includes evening hours and/or free time regardless of age.
