



Diagnostic, Formative, & Summative Assessments

Purposes and Differences

Diagnostic Assessment

- ▶ Assessment at either:
 - ▶ the beginning of a school year *or*
 - ▶ a new unit
- ▶ Provides the teacher with information about what students already know and are able to do
- ▶ Completed **BEFORE** teaching

Formative Assessment

- ▶ Monitoring student progress
- ▶ Includes feedback
- ▶ Includes opportunities for students to use feedback and make improvements
- ▶ Student performance on formative assessments should **not** be used for grading purposes
- ▶ Examples: homework, ungraded quizzes, ungraded classroom assignments
- ▶ Completed **DURING** instruction

Summative Assessment

- ▶ A summing up of what students have learned
- ▶ Examples: exams, projects, papers
- ▶ Summative assessments are graded
- ▶ Completed **AFTER** instruction
