

Student Code of Ethics

If campers do not abide by the code of ethics they may be asked to leave camp.

PARTICIPANTS SHOULD NOT:

- Install or download programs on camp devices from the internet or from flash drives
- Try alternative ways to access sites on the internet that are blocked by the Winthrop filter
- Log in to the computer as another user or give out their username and password
- View, delete, share, open, or modify files that do not belong to them unless directed to do so
- Tamper with or modify any equipment
- Visit web sites for gaming, shopping, or other non-camp related reasons
- Use their phone or other personal devices while participating in camp except for purposes of taking photos or videos of their projects
- Use their phone or other personal devices to take photos of camp staff or participants without permission
- Leave the ITC without permission of the camp director or counselors
- Display acts of aggression or unkindness to others

PARTICIPANTS SHOULD:

- Abide by copyright guidelines when creating projects
- Notify the Camp Director or Counselor if the computer or other technology equipment is not working correctly so that it can be fixed
- Be sure that all work done will be camp appropriate
- Do their best to take care of the technology equipment they use
- Use the internet for the purposes of researching for and completing camp projects
- Participate with kindness when working with other campers and camp staff
- Notify camp staff if they need to leave the room for any reason
