OBSERVATION CYCLE

- <u>LESSON PLAN</u> –TALK WITH MENTOR TO DISCUSS PLAN AND RELEVANT LEARNING GOALS
- OBSERVATION PRE-CONFERENCE ALLOWS TIME FOR THE TEACHER CANDIDATE AND OBSERVER TO DISCUSS THE PLAN BEFORE IMPLEMENTING IT (CLARIFY GOALS, ASSESSMENTS, MATERIALS, STRATEGIES/PROCEDURES, ETC.)
- OBSERVATION- COLLECTION OF DATA TEACHER CANDIDATE NEEDS TO REFLECT AFTER OBSERVATION ON IMPRESSIONS OF THE LESSON
- OBSERVATION POST-CONFERENCE TIME FOR REFLECTION CONVERSATION
 WITH OBSERVER- USE OF ASSESSMENT DATA TO GUIDE CONVERSATION

- MENTOR TEACHER 4 OBSERVATIONS (2 BEFORE MIDTERM AND 2 AFTER MIDTERM)
- SUPERVISOR 2 OBSERVATIONS (1 BEFORE MIDTERM AND 1 AFTER MIDTERM
- SITE-BASED OBSERVER 2 OBSERVATIONS (1 BEFORE MIDTERM AND 1 AFTER MIDTERM THE MENTOR IDENTIFIES THE SITE-BASED OBSERVER BUT IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO SET UP THE OBSERVATIONS.
- ALL OBSERVATIONS ARE TO BE COMPLETED ON YOUR PROGRAM AREA TEMPLATE.


CLASSROOM PROTOCOL

- DON'T LET NEGATIVE CO-WORKERS GET THEIR "HOOKS" IN YOU...YOU CAN EITHER BE DRAGGED INTO THEIR PIT OR YOU CAN DO WHAT IS BEST FOR STUDENTS.
- ASK LOTS OF QUESTIONS TEACHERS ARE MORE THAN WILLING TO SHARE IDEAS, RESOURCES, ETC. QUESTIONING DOES NOT MAKE YOU LOOK INCOMPETENT.
- AVOID ACTING (RESPONDING, SENDING EMAILS...) WHEN ANGRY!!
- KEEP PERSONAL "STUFF" SEPARATE.
