 - 1. Lack of initiative with Junior Field
 - 2. Schools are working hard on motivation but the past couple of years we have worked so differently virtually, zoom, and various forms of flexibility but now students, teachers, and interns need to reign it in.
 - 3. High School Difficulty of Spring semester, a lot of adjustments to fill in for teachers who have been pulled. Field trips it's common for a host teacher not to be on campus the day there is a scheduled field experience. We need a firm commitment from host teachers that they will be there if they said they will host.
 - a) Is a Fall semester option easier? Scale back on the number?
 - 4. Elementary Lack of initiative (even without the pandemic).
 - a) Competition of politeness student doesn't want to step on teacher's toes and teacher is saying feel free to do such and such or not saying directly, "Go check on that table." Role as a mentor is to tell student to go do something unless this is done seriously some will go back to the shadows until they know it's a good/safe thing to do.
 - 5. We can't assume interns are ready to do something we need to reiterate this with our host and mentor teachers.

 - 1. Comment Definitely needed but maybe later. Middle level is hard Middle-Level are going to assist Elementary Level counselors. Maybe in early August.
 - 2. Mental Health 1st Aid Training very intense 8 hours Help teachers develop tools to help students survive in that moment and get them to the resources they need. How to work with someone experiencing a crisis situation (not to the level of suicidal) but panicattacks (for example). Background in some different mental health problems and why someone is reacting the way they are. What to do until a trained professional is able to be there or found. Faculty member in the College of Education's Physical Education, Sport, & Human Performance (PESH) Department. We hope to offer training this summer and Fall.
