## **Additional Requirements:**

- 1. Entering freshman can declare Family and Consumer Sciences as a major.
- 2. All FMCS students must achieve a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5 prior to registering for any Family and Consumer Sciences courses, except FACS 101.
- 3. All FMCS students must select a specialization: Adolescent Studies; Consumer Studies; or Early Childhood Studies.
- 4. Students must meet all University requirements and earn a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or greater in order to graduate.
- 5. The following courses are restricted to Family and Consumer Sciences majors or minors in good standing (a 2.5 minimum cumulative grade point average) or with permission of the instructor: FACS 211, 350, 401, 495, 500, 501, 502 and 573.
- 6. Complete a minimum of 40 hours of courses numbered above 299. In order to meet this University requirement, students may have to take courses above 299 as their electives.
