## Internship I

- Placements are confirmed with students (if all requirements are met) in April, including invitations to “Meet & Greet” sessions scheduled for late April/May
- Internship I requirements must be met no later than August 1<sup>st</sup>
- You will start back to school when your assigned mentor teacher reports to school. This is *before* Winthrop starts so plan your summer accordingly.
- You will be engage all day, every day until Winthrop classes begin.
- Applications for Internship II will be in the fall. Look for an email from Ms. Hablutzel.



# Placements

- An intern may **not** be assigned to a mentor who is a relative or close family friend
- An intern may **not** be assigned to a school where the principal or other administrator is a family member.
- An intern may **not** be assigned to a school that his/her children attend.
- The only other circumstances that may impact your school placement are circumstances such as childcare situations or documented medical conditions. **WORK SCHEDULE & LOCATION** are not valid circumstances that will impact your placement.

- It is not recommended that you take any course work during Internship II other than the Internship II courses (EDUC 410 and EDCI 450). All remaining coursework should be completed Fall semester!  
Thoroughly review Degreeworks to ensure all courses are completed before Spring 2021
- Other courses include: GEOG 101, EDCO 350, GEOL 110/113, HIST 211 or EDUC 312, EDCO 305, ECED 395\* PHYS 250

## Recommendations



- We recommend you plan to take Praxis II over the summer. You are required to pass **BEFORE** starting Internship II
  - ECED – Education of Young Children (5024) *[passing score is 160]*
  - ELEM (optional add-on) – Elementary Education: Multiple Subjects (5001)
- When registering, it is critical that you list Winthrop University (5910) **and** the SC Department of Education (8108) as score recipients.



**PRAXIS vouchers** can be requested for students who are planning on taking a PRAXIS test. The cost of the test will then be charged to your student account. Student Academic Services will place an order for the requested vouchers five times per year (May 1, July 1, September 1, December 1, and March 1). To request a voucher, please complete the **PRAXIS Voucher Request Form** online, print it off and return to Student Academic Services in 144 Withers.

## Students

- Log in to DegreeWorks on your electronic device
