PRAXIS vouchers can be requested for students who are planning on taking a PRAXIS test. The cost of the test will then be charged to your student account. Student Academic Services will place an order for the requested vouchers five times per year (May 1, July 1, September 1, December 1, and March 1). You must meet the testing requirement before the start of classes the semester in which you are enrolled in EDCO 201.

If this requirement is not met by that time, students will be administratively enrolled immediately after the add/drop period. Test scores typically take at least two weeks to arrive at Winthrop. If you have not met the testing requirement and plan to enroll in EDCO 201 this fall, we strongly recommend you take the chosen test no later than July 1 to ensure ample processing time. The course does not require traditional tuition and instead a \$65 fee is assessed to cover study materials with all expectations completed online.

Recommendations



- Take & successfully pass Core Academic Skills for Educators Test or PRAXIS I (or its equivalents)
- Plan to apply to the Teacher Education Program NO later than Spring of your Sophomore year (April 1st 2021) (*see requirements for Admission*)
- Follow course sequence of Program Checklist and stay on track
- 12 – 18 credit hrs is considered a full load. If you would like to register for more than 18 hrs you will need to wait until grades for Spring 2020 are posted. You will need a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above to register for up to 21 hrs.
- You must complete CRTW 201 by the time you earn 75 credit hrs.

Students can apply for admission once they have:

1. Viewed the videos on admission to the Teacher Education Program.
2. Completed a minimum of 45 semester hours, 15 of which must be completed at Winthrop.
3. Maintained a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75 for coursework completed at Winthrop.
4. Completed the following core courses with a grade of “C” or better: EDCO 101, EDCO 200, and EDCO 201 or EDCO 202 or equivalents.
5. Achieved satisfactory field evaluations in EDCO 200 and EDCO 201 or EDCO 202 or equivalents.
6. Passed all three sections of either the PRAXIS Core Academic Skills for Educators Test or PRAXIS I or have satisfied the testing requirements with minimum scores on the SAT, SAT I, or ACT.



For examinations taken September 1, 2016 or later students can meet requirements with a single composite score or with sub area scores from a variety of examinations. All students must meet the requirements in Mathematics, Reading, and Writing to satisfy the state testing requirements for admission to the Teacher Education Program which gives access to registration for restricted coursework.
