- × READ 346
  - × NOTE: YOU MAY TAKE READ 331 BUT IT IS A FALL ONLY COURSE
- × EDCO 350

# Praxis II – Content Area Tests

- Take them when you feel MOST CONFIDENT about the content
  - At the end of a semester when completing 2 or 3 content courses
  - At the end of the semester when taking Methods

#### • Important Facts To Know:

- You will not be allowed to enroll in Internship II without a passing score on at least ONE Content area test.
- PRAXIS offers Full Practice test for \$20 TAKE ONE BEFORE TESTING! (This will be a requirement of MLED 330)

# Senior Year Internship Requirements

#### O KNOW and PLAN Now...

#### O Fall Internship I

- All students MUST report to their Internship Placement School on the first day teachers report (usually the second week of August – BEFORE Winthrop starts!)
- You will go to your placement EVERY day, ALL day, Monday-Friday until Winthrop classes begin
- $\circ$  Once Winthrop starts, you will go to your placement (2) ½ days and (1) full day Friday

#### Spring Internship II

- All students MUST report to their internship Placement School on the day school resumes in January
- O You will go to your placement EVERY day, ALL day, Monday-Friday until late April
- O You will take Spring Break with your Internship school you will not have Winthrop's Spring Break

# **Cultural Events**

- O You must attend 18 Cultural Events BEFORE graduation
- Transfer students will be required to attend 3 cultural events for every 20 hours needed to reach 120 hours.
- O In addition to attending <u>Cultural Events</u>, students can complete this requirement by <u>submitting a petition to receive Cultural Event credit</u> for past experiences that are considered to be culturally significant. These include:
  - On-Campus Events
  - Off-Campus Events
  - Travel Experiences
  - Military Experiences (student veterans)
  - Portfolio of Experiences (post-traditional students)

# Supplemental Education Experience (SEE) Credits – required starting 2019-2020

- Minimum Requirements:
  - 6 events (two per category)
  - Diverse Students
    - At least one session on the IEP process\*
    - Session of your choice offered in this category
  - Critical Incidences
    - Mandatory Reporter Session
    - O Darkness to Light Training (offered as part of the Internship experiences)
  - Professionalism
    - Mock Interview
    - O Session of your choice (which can include attendance at a conference or school-based professional development event with prior approval and appropriate documentation)
- Students are responsible for maintaining their own documentation of completion.
