

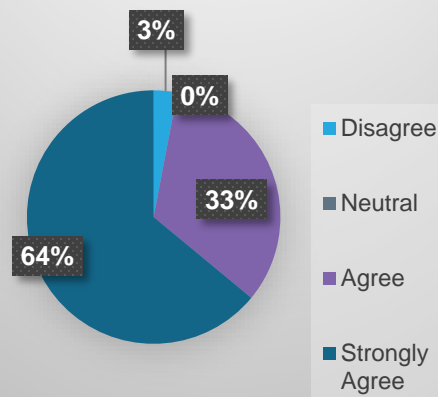

## 2016 Exit Survey Satisfaction with Site & Faculty Supervision



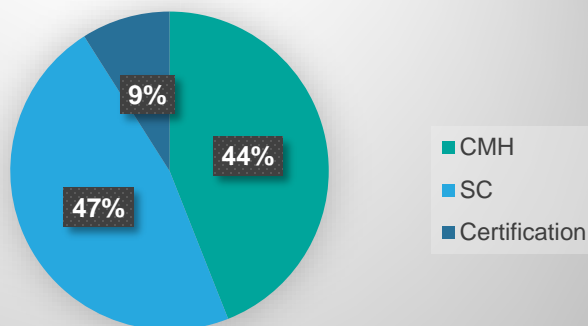
