

- Check-out days for Fall 2022: September 7th – November 18th
- Check-out dates for Spring 2023: January 10th – March 13th
- Length = 15 business days* Unless you are a part of the following majors: (Elementary PESH, Visual Arts, Performing Arts, and Music students), you will have 30 calendar days.
- 15 Business Days Example: Checkout September 7th items will be due back September 28th.
 - **Please note: all equipment will need to be returned by March 13th even if you haven't met your 15 business days.**
- You are only allowed to check out edTPA equipment once during this period due to high demand
 - Unless you receive permissions from the Director of the ITC and your Supervisor

Procedures

- You **MUST** use SignUp Genius to reserve equipment
 - [Fall 2022 EdTPA SignUpGenius](#)
 - [Spring 2023 EdTPA SignUpGenius](#)
 - You may sign up for **one** slot at a time. Multiple slots will be deleted.
 - If you do not pick up your equipment on the reserved date, you will have **3 business days** before it's re-shelved and you need to sign up for a new date.
- Please bring your Student ID and make sure to have your WU number handy
- Prepare for check-in and check-out to take 15-30 minutes

Check-out process

- Equipment – tripod, camera set, and microphone set
 - ADDITIONAL item = SD card
 - Initial off for EACH item on table

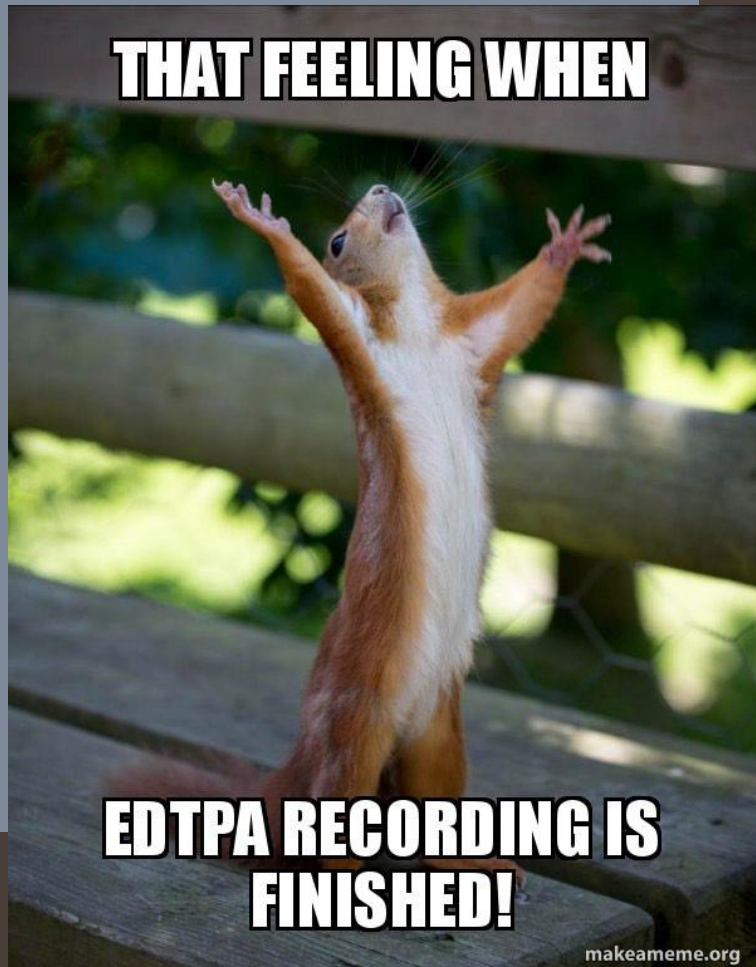

Tips for Keeping Items Secure	

- LATE FEES
 - \$25 a day – does accrue over weekends
 - Due back before the ITC closes on its due date
- Late equipment fees, damaged equipment fees, and missing equipment fees must be paid in order to graduate

Check-in process

- Paperwork
- Equipment – tripod, camera set, and microphone set
 - ADDITIONAL = SD card
- If ITC staff notices any missing or damaged equipment that was not noted on your checkout form, you will be charged on your student account for this
 - This is why both student and staff sign for both check-in and check-out

PLANNING AHEAD



- Given all this information, please PLAN AHEAD
- Talk with your host teacher – plan at the beginning for a time to record later
- Try to not plan for the very end – equipment may not be available
- Pick up your equipment a few days before you are recording – not the day before/day of
