

# 34th Undergraduate Juried Exhibition Information

## Entry Procedure

Submit up to six entries to the Rutledge Gallery on **January 18 & 19** between 9 - 12 p.m. or 1 - 5 p.m.

Jurying will take place January 21.

All unaccepted work must be picked up in the Rutledge Gallery **January 24 & 25** between 9 - 12 p.m. or 1 - 5 p.m.

Exhibited work must be picked up in the Rutledge Gallery **March 7 & 8** between 9 - 12 p.m. or 1 - 5 p.m.

All work must be submitted in a professional manner and ready for installation. You can find more information on professional standards and installation methods on the following page.

All entries must have been completed within the past 12 months and while studying at Winthrop University.

Collaborative works will count as half an entry for each creator.

All work must be accompanied by an entry form, to be completed at the time of submission.

Students are encouraged to fill out the Entry Artwork Tags prior to January 18 and bring the completed tags (one tag attached to each artwork) with their artwork to Rutledge Gallery on January 18 & 19 from 9 - 12 p.m. or 1 - 5 p.m. Entry Artwork Tags will be available in the hallway outside of the Rutledge Gallery through January 18.

Site-specific installation proposals must be presented in a professional manner and include 1) detailed drawings or images, 2) a description of the installation processes and materials, and 3) an artist statement. These proposals are due to the Rutledge Gallery January 19 by 5 p.m. If accepted, the artist must install the work. Site-specific installations must be installed by the artists under the supervision of Winthrop University Galleries between January 24 and February 3.

The gallery reserves the right to reject any artwork due to inadequate preparation for installation, potential security or public safety issues.

Accepted works cannot be withdrawn before the end of the show. Accepted work can be picked up **March 7 & 8** from 9 - 12 p.m. or 1 - 5 p.m. Any work left at Winthrop University Galleries after March 9, 2022 will become the property of Winthrop.

## Sale of Artwork

Artists may choose to have their work available for purchase throughout the exhibit. Work cannot be withdrawn before the end of the show due to sale. A patrons' viewing of all work submitted will take place January 20. Purchase awards will be chosen by patrons at this time. Work does not have to be accepted into the exhibition in order to be sold.

## Awards

All works selected by the juror will be included in the *34th Annual Undergraduate Juried Exhibition* in the Rutledge Gallery and online February 7 - March 4, 2022. Awards will be presented to the artists chosen by the juror during the opening reception on Thursday, February 10 from 5:30 p.m. to 7 p.m.

## Eligibility

UJE is open to all Winthrop Fine Arts and Design undergraduate students. Entries must be original works in any art and design media. Site-specific installation proposals will be accepted (See above for details). Size and weight should be considered for installation in the gallery space. The juror will be looking for quality work not quantity.
