How do I register my child?

Payment Plan

The first payment is due with registration. The remaining payments are due on the 16th of each succeeding month (Feb, Mar, Apr). Credit card payments may be paid online http://www.winthrop.edu/marketplacemall or a check may be dropped in the brown lockbox outside of the music office.

Withdrawal/Refund Policy

No full refunds will be made after January 26th. If a request for a refund is made before lessons officially begin, a full refund minus a \$25.00 processing fee will be granted. If a request for a refund is made after the official start of the semester, it is the responsibility of the student, parent, and/or legal guardian to pay the \$25.00 processing fee in addition to the tuition for the remainder of the month.

Make-up Policy

If the student must miss a lesson, the instructor should be contacted at least 24 hours in advance of the scheduled lesson. With proper notification, instructors will make up lessons missed when possible, however they are *not* required to make-up more than one missed lesson caused by the student's absence.

^{*}Lessons in every instrument may not be available each semester. If an instructor can not be secured by the beginning of the semester, a full refund will be offered, and the student will be placed on a waiting list.
