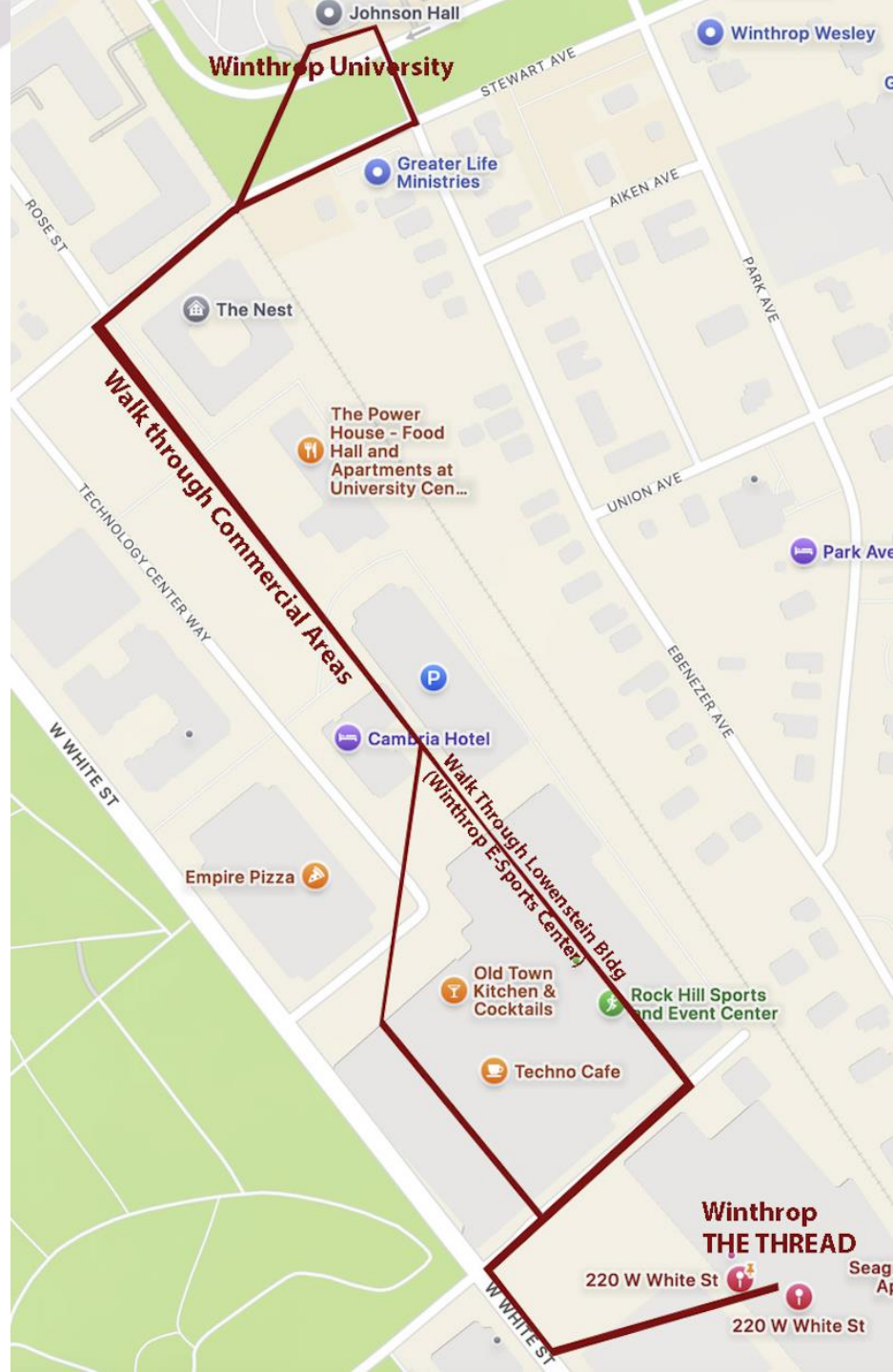

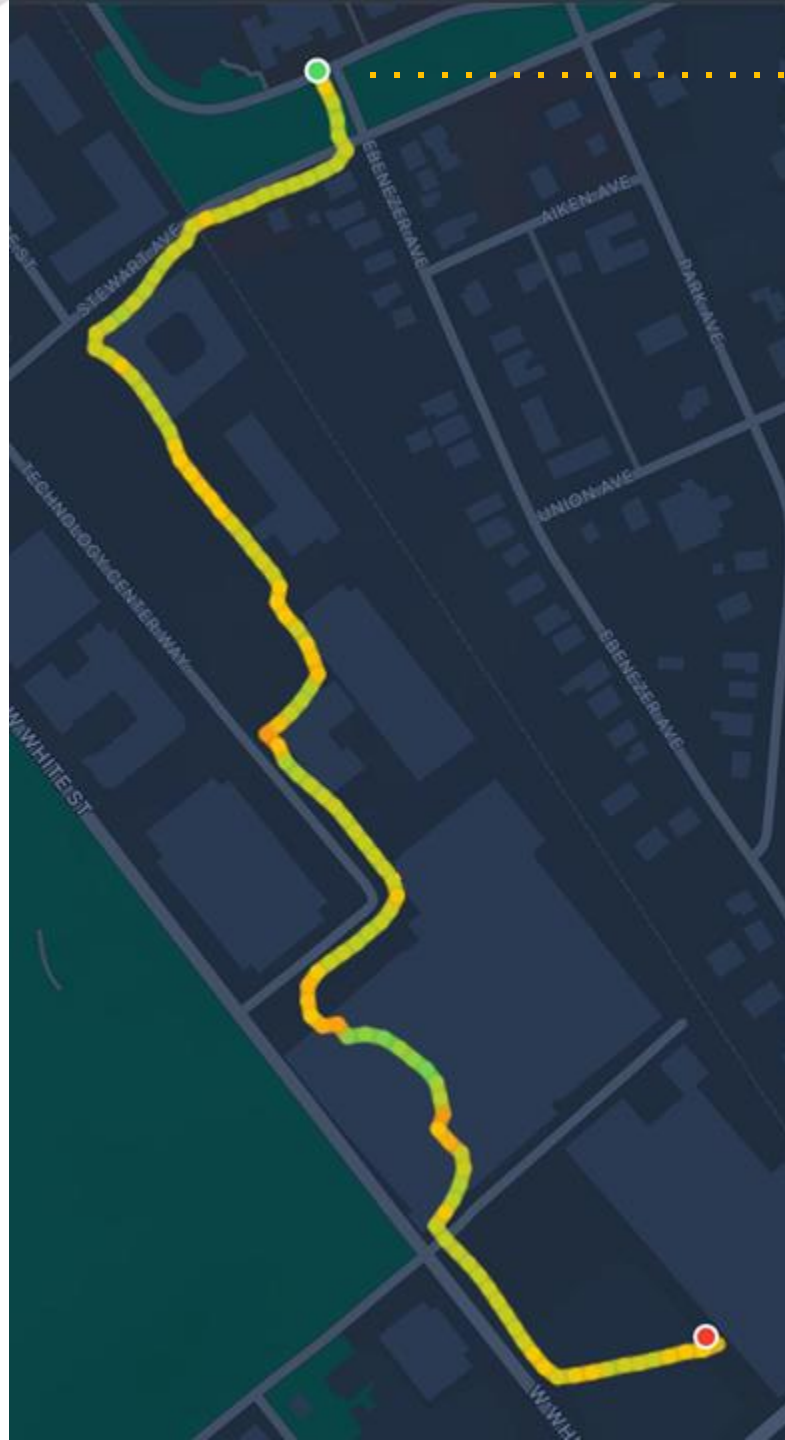
Walking Route / The Thread

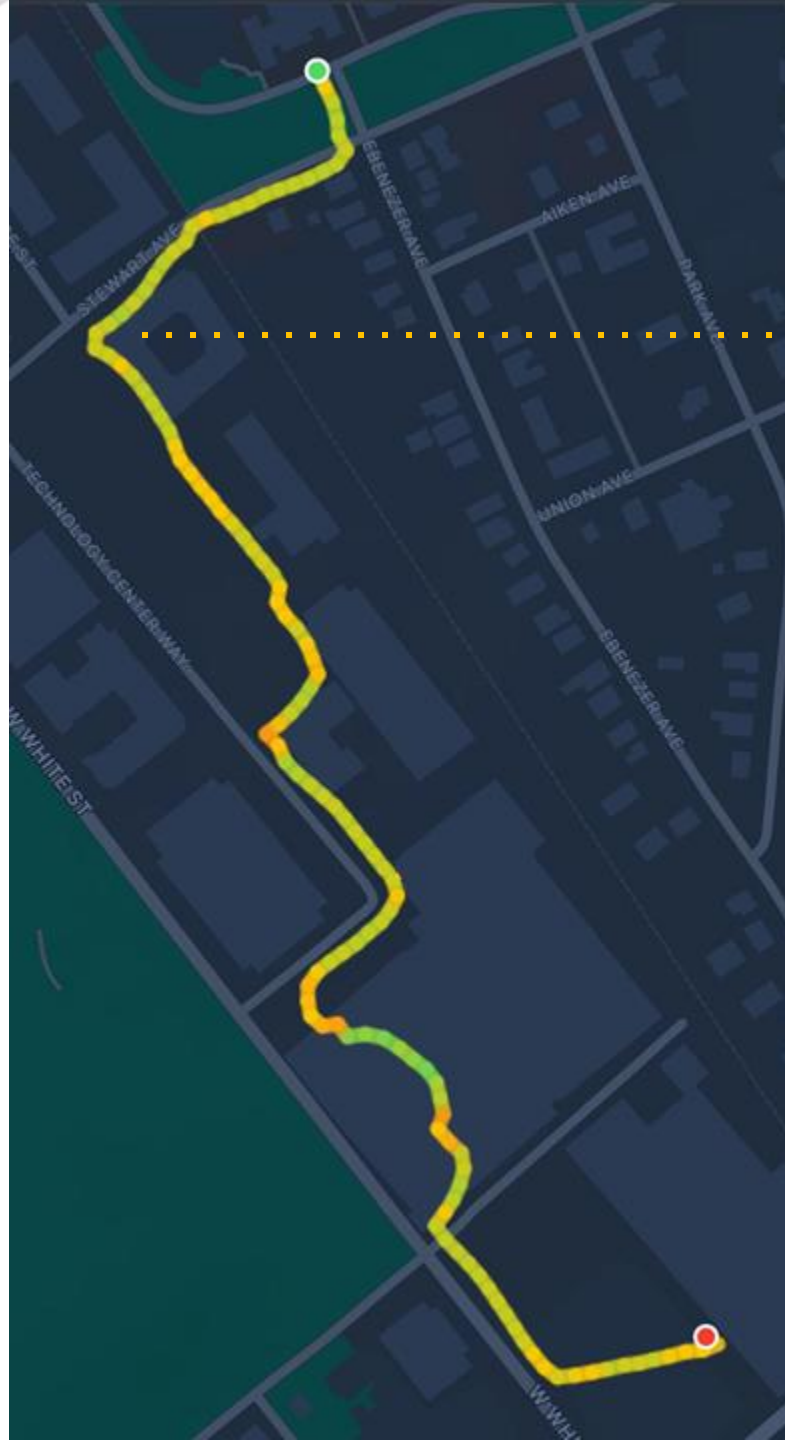

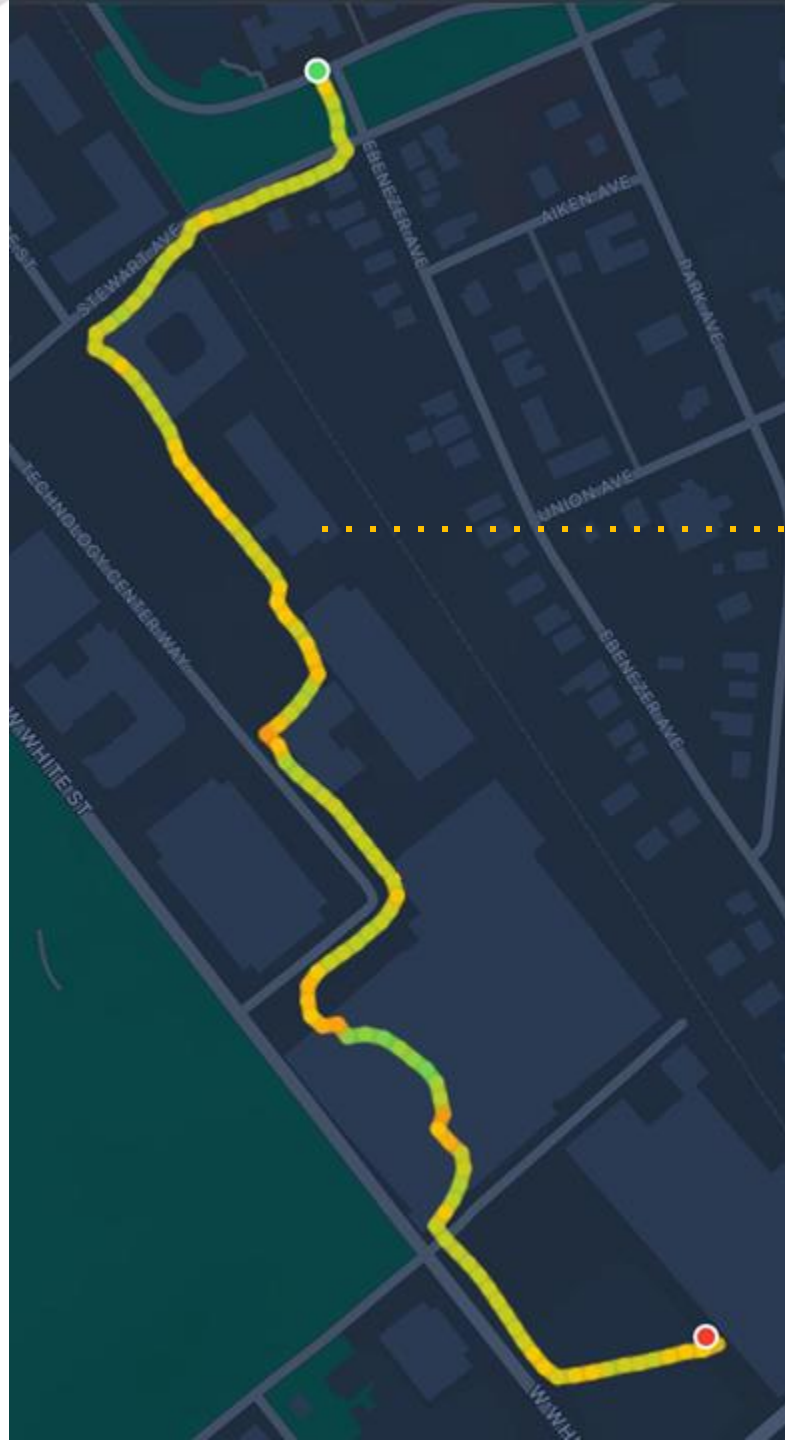

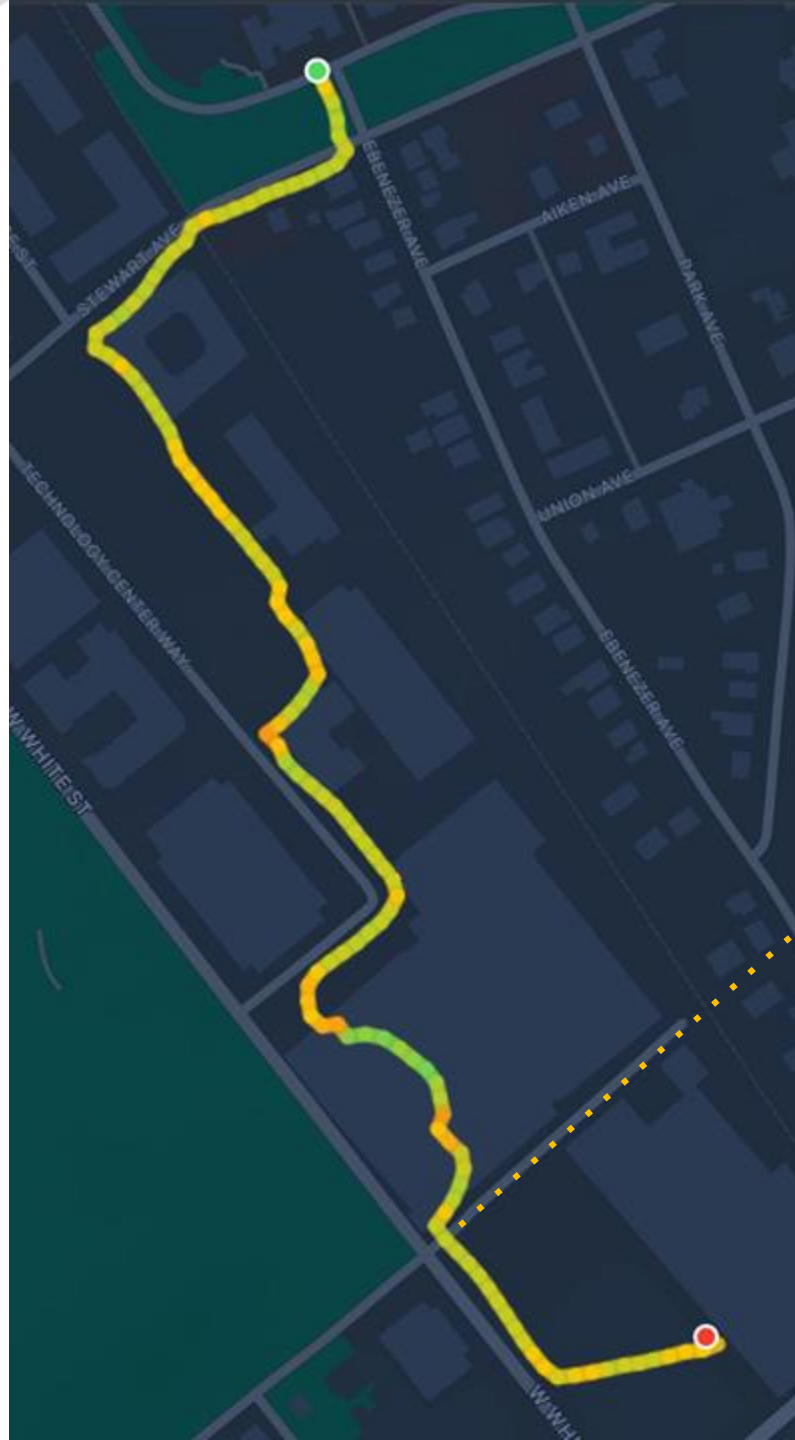

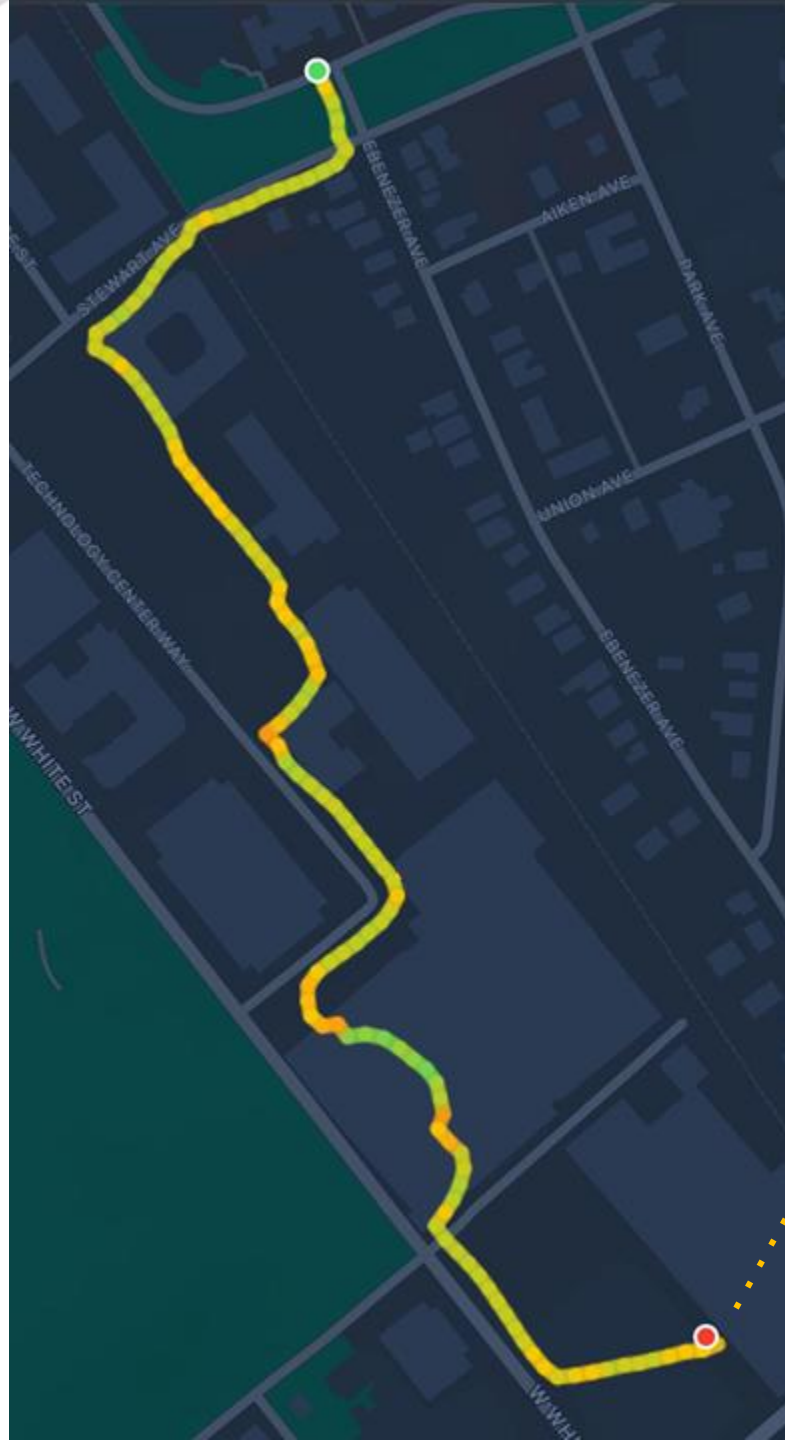
Lowenstein, exit to sidewalk, The Thread

# Other Transport- Shuttle

# Other Transport- **Winthrop Police Escort**

WUPD has a Safety Escort program, details about which can be found online at <https://www.winthrop.edu/police/safety-escorts.aspx>.

- This service is offered every day from 6 PM to 6 AM.
- individuals must contact WUPD every time they need the escort service
- Limitations include availability (first come first serve)
- They prioritize calls for service, so if multiple escorts come in and they get a call for service involving a crime in progress, WUPD must answer those as the priority.
- The safety escorts do not require any other paperwork or waivers.



# Other Transport- Accessible Public Transport

- Students who meet any of the eligibility requirements are encouraged to apply for paratransit service. Under the ADA regulations, qualified individuals fall into at least one of following three categories:
- The applicant is unable, because of mental or physical impairment as defined in the ADA, to get on, ride, or get off an accessible vehicle of the *My Ride* fixed route bus system.
- The applicant needs the assistance of a wheelchair lift or other boarding device and is able, with such assistance, to get on, ride, and get off an accessible vehicle, BUT such a vehicle is not available on the route the person wants to travel.
- The applicant has a specific impairment-related condition (including limitations of vision, hearing, or disorientation), which prevents travel to or from a transit station or stop of the My Ride fixed route bus system
