___ **Junior Recital** (half recital) in the major instrument (fall semester of junior year)

___ **Senior Recital** (full recital) in the major instrument (fall semester of senior year).

___ 8 semesters of approved **recital attendance (80 recitals)**.

* FOOTNOTES

³ **Small Ensemble Requirement:** All BM students must complete at least two semesters of small ensemble – students must complete at least two semesters of small ensemble (may not include MUSA 151, 152, 156, 157, 158, or 161).

⁴ **MUSA/MUST Electives above 299:** Any courses in MUSA or MUST above 299 except MUST 315 (**voice majors** must include MUST 319, 321-322; no more than 3 hours of private lessons may be counted here).
 hours of applied music credit may be counted in this area.

⁵ **MUSA/MUST 5__:** any 500-level MUST elective (**piano majors** must include MUST 501 and 520; **voice majors** must include MUST 505 or 509; **percussion majors** must include MUST 517).

MINIMUM GRADE REQUIREMENT

Music majors must receive a minimum grade of **C (2.0)** in every music course (MUSA or MUST) used to meet degree requirements.
