Program FAQ

How do I register my child?

Registration forms can be found at Winthrop.edu/music under the Academy of Music link. Once the form has been completed, it must be emailed to academyofmusic@winthrop.edu or dropped off in the Academy of Music office.

Is there a registration fee?

Yes, only new students are required to pay a registration fee of \$25.00. This fee is due with the first installment payment at the time of registration.

What is the cost of tuition?

Tuition is based on several variables including instructor level, the length of the lesson, and the instrument of study. For full details please refer to the tuition chart of the inside panel.

How many lessons does the tuition cover?

The tuition for the Summer 2024 covers either Session I, II, or both Sessions I and II. Each session runs for 5 consecutive weeks.

When will my child's lessons be?

Lessons are set up between you and the instructor. Once your child has been assigned an instructor, the instructor will contact you directly to set up the lesson day and time.

Where are lessons held?

Lessons will be taught in person on in the music conservatory at Winthrop.

Tuition

Full payment for one 5-week session, or the 10-week session is due at the time of registration.

Withdrawal/Refund Policy

No full refunds will be made after May 31st 2024. If a request for a refund is made before lessons officially begin, a full refund minus a \$25.00 processing fee will be granted. If a request for a refund is made after the official start of the semester, it is the responsibility of the student, parent, and/or legal guardian to pay the \$25.00 processing fee in addition to the tuition for the remainder of the month.

Make-up Policy

If the student must miss a lesson, the instructor should be contacted at least 24 hours in advance of the scheduled lesson. With proper notification, instructors will make up lessons missed when possible, however they are *not* required to make-up more than one missed lesson caused by the student's absence.
