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### Fast Facts

You must earn a "C-" or better in WRIT 101, HMXP 102, CRTW 201 by the time you have completed 75 earned hours.

You must have an overall 2.0 GPA and a minimum of 120 semester hours to graduate from Winthrop University.

You are required to attend three cultural events for every 20 hours completed at Winthrop, not to exceed 18 events.

The Technology Requirement and CRTW 201 MUST be completed by the time a student reaches 75 earned credit hours

Designators that differ only for the purpose of theory and application will be considered the same designator. i.e: THRT and THRA are one designators. DANA and DANT are one designator.

No more than 36 hours in any one subject or course designator may apply to the BA degree.

Dance and Theatre majors must earn a C- or better in all courses in their major program.
