CHOREOGRAPHER & DIRECTOR NOTE:

“MOMENTS OF ICARUS” IS A COLLABORATIVE PROJECT THAT EXPLORES THE SHEDDING OF ADOLESCENCE. THE STORY OF ICARUS INHERENTLY TOUCHES ON THEMES OF OVERINDULGENCE, EXCESSIVE PRIDE, AND SELF-VICTIMIZATION—HE ULTIMATELY PUT HIMSELF IN THE POSITION WHERE HE ENDED UP. I WANTED TO EXPLORE THIS THROUGH THE LENS OF LIFE IN YOUR TWENTIES: A CONSTANT CYCLE OF POWERING THROUGH, DEALING WITH THE MESSES YOU MAKE, AND THE MADNESS THAT COMES WITH TRANSITIONING INTO ADULTHOOD.

THROUGHOUT THE PROCESS WITH THE INCREDIBLE CAST, WE DISCOVERED A SHARED IDEA OF THIS STAGE IN LIFE: AN INDEPENDENT DEPENDENCY. MANY COLLEGE-AGED ADULTS FIND THEMSELVES LIVING TWO LIVES—GROWING INTO A MORE DEVELOPED SELF WHILE STILL BEING EXPECTED TO BE THE EIGHTEEN-YEAR-OLD WHO LEFT HOME.
