Overview

Winthrop University's mission emphasizes the University's collective responsibility to help students "acquire and develop knowledge, skills, capabilities, and values that enrich their lives and prepare them to meet the needs and challenges of the contemporary world."

Student Learning Outcomes
The GLI will address three broad student learning outcomes (SLO):

1. Global Knowledge
Students will demonstrate awareness and comprehension of various cultures and their impact on global society.

2. Global Attitudes
Students will exhibit attitudes and behaviors that reflect cultural self-awareness and respect for and acceptance of cultural perspectives different from their own.

3. Global Engagement
Students will exhibit global civic responsibility by engaging effectively with others in diverse intercultural groups and settings.
