To meet the requirements to qualify for a new loan, you must provide a signed physician's statement that you may now engage in "substantial gainful activity." **The statement must be from a Doctor of Medicine (MD) or Doctor of Osteopathy (DO) and use the words "substantial gainful activity."** Students who provided a physician statement for 25/26 probably will not need to provide a new physician statement. Contact the Office of Financial Aid to confirm a new statement is not needed.

I have attached the required documentation mentioned above. I understand that taking out a new federally funded educational loan or TEACH Grant cannot be later discharged for any present impairment unless it deteriorates so that it is once again a total and permanent disability.
