- Deadline to submit request: March 1, 2025
- Special consideration is generally given only for those circumstances described below because many adjustments are already considered in the calculation from the FAFSA.
- Typically, the only additional type of financial aid the student may be eligible to receive is the federal Pell Grant, and the possibility of reallocating some of their unsubsidized loan into a subsidized loan (if they aren't already receiving the maximum allowable amount based on grade level).

- 1. A brief letter describing the special circumstances to be considered.
- **2.** Submit the following Dependent Verification forms:
  - a. 24/25 Verification Dependent (www.winthrop.edu/finaid/forms-online.aspx).
  - b. 24/25 Tax Return Verification Student Dependent (<a href="www.winthrop.edu/finaid/forms-online.aspx">www.winthrop.edu/finaid/forms-online.aspx</a>).
  - c. SIGNED copy of parent's 2022 federal tax return (1040)
