Christine Kirouac: Siren Fall

Canadian artist, Christine Kirouac's work explores the "performance" of ethnicity and identity through lenses of cliché, storytelling, mimicry, and popular culture. Kirouac's videos and installations move between enigmatic acts of personal revelation and social observation, blending elements of cinema, theatre and documentary. "Siren Fall" captures young Canadian girls interpreting military fashion through the filters of suburbia.

Sonya Clark: Material Reflex
Rutledge Gallery / Rutledge Building
"Material Reflex" explores Clark's symbolic and innovative interpretation of materials and weaving processes as a reflection of personal and cultural identity. Drawing from her African-American, Scottish and Caribbean roots, Clark takes seemingly common objects such as a piece of cloth or a strand of human hair and transforms them into historical commentary, challenging the viewer to embrace the subliminal context. Clark is currently the chair of the Department of Craft/Material Studies at Virginia Commonwealth University in Richmond, Virginia and most recently was recognized as a United States Artist Fellow.
