Criteria for Winthrop Graduate Assistantship/Associateship:

- Graduate assistantships and associateships are awarded to students who are fully and provisionally admitted to graduate degree programs.
- To retain a graduate assistantship or associateship, the student must maintain academic eligibility and may not be on academic probation.
- Non-degree students may not hold graduate assistantships/associateships.
- Students enrolled for student teaching are ineligible to serve as a graduate assistant/associate that semester.
- Students must enroll in a minimum of 9 credit hours for their Employment and Wage Agreement to be processed.
