

Application for Graduate Foundation Scholarship

Criteria for Winthrop Graduate Foundation Scholarship:

- Recipients are selected on the basis of availability and future promise
- Provisionally admitted students are eligible to apply for and receive the same financial aid benefits as fully admitted students. Non-degree students are ineligible to receive special awards.
- Students on academic probation cannot be awarded a scholarship.
- Students must be enrolled in a degree program during the semester or semesters for which the award is given. Future graduate students must have applied for admission to a graduate program in order for their scholarship applications to be processed.
- Scholarships represent an outright gift from the Winthrop Foundation and require a thank you note that is coordinated through the Foundation office.
- Award amounts vary, but range between \$250 and \$500 per semester.
