The Winthrop University MBA program will consider GMAT/GRE test waiver requests from qualified applicants. A waiver may be granted if the MBA applicant's previous educational accomplishments and/or work experience demonstrate quantitative and analytical readiness for the quantitatively oriented coursework of an MBA program.

GMAT/GRE waiver requests will be considered for MBA applicants who meet one of the following waiver criteria and must be requested when completing the application online. Please select one:

A minimum of five years of professional experience with increasing levels of responsibility, with an undergraduate GPA of 3.0 or higher, and at least four courses that average a 3.0 GPA in the areas of math, statistics, economics, finance, or accounting.

Four years of post-baccalaureate experience with an earned professional credential such as a CPA, CFP, PE license, CMA, CFE, CIA, etc.

Waiver requests based on other criteria will be reviewed on a case by case basis. If you have alternative educational or professional accomplishments that you believe merit a waiver, please submit a resume and essay explaining the justification for your request.

Note: GMAT/GRE waivers are not guaranteed to those who meet one of the above criteria. The applicant's entire application packet will be considered when a GMAT/GRE waiver decision is made. All waivers that meet the requirements above will be forwarded to the CBA Graduate Petitions Committee for approval.
