August Dates

- Campus total will be determined at the Recruitment Meeting on **August 20th**, **2018** in Digs 114 at 7p.m. All membership rosters must be updated and turned into the Office of Fraternity & Sorority Affairs no later than **12-noon on August 20th**, **2018**.
- There will be an open CPC Informational session (Greek 101) on Wednesday, August 22nd, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. in *Richardson Ballroom B*.
- Rho Gamma selection process will begin on Thursday, August 23rd, 2018 with interviews.
- Informal Recruitment events can begin Thursday, August 23rd, 2018 after 10:30 a.m.
- Bids may be extended beginning after 5:00 p.m. August 24th, 2018 as long as they have been verified by OFSA through the online interest form and added to the CPC Eligibility list Recruitment Chairs will gain access to upon completion of attending the Membership Policy Workshop on Tuesday, August 22nd, 2018 at 11:00 a.m.
- The women selected for the Rho Gamma positions will be notified of their position no later than **Monday**, **August 27th**, **2018**.
- Personal social media accounts and any other personalized web page(s) for disaffiliates should be free of their affiliation on Thursday, August 30th, 2018 until after new member reveal. CPC Exec is to monitor the sites.
 No affiliation of sorority, fraternity, or other social groups may be associated or displayed; this includes but is not limited to relationship statuses, fan pages, prior/current sorority titles, etc.
 - o Facebook: Account must be set to private and remove any sorority paraphernalia on profile pictures and cover photos before **August 30th, 2018**. These members will return to basic profiles and will not display profile picture containing sisters that are not disaffiliated.
 - Must use personal instagram as "Go Greek" account for the purpose of connecting with PNMS, promoting Panhellenic events and formal recruitment.

September Dates

• There will be an open CPC Informational session (Greek 101) on Wednesday, September 19th, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. in *Richardson Ballroom B*.

October Dates

- If a chapter has <u>not</u> reached total they may submit more COB events through **Tuesday**, **October 2nd**, **2018** in order to have an 8 week new member education process. If the chapter's new member process is shorter than 8 weeks, the chapter can COB until total is reached with an approved new member process from the Assistant Director of Student Activities for Fraternity & Sorority Affairs.
- There will be an open CPC Informational session (Greek 101) on **Wednesday, October 17th, 2018 at 7:00 p.m**. in *Richardson Ballroom B*.

November Dates

- Formal Recruitment Registration opens on CPC Day: November 3rd, 2018.
- "Formal Recruitment Period" refers to CPC Day on **November 3rd, 2018** and will last until Bid Day of the Spring Semester on **January 20, 2019.**
- All Panhellenic organizations must be in compliance by CPC Day, November 3rd, 2018. Failure to adhere to these clauses will result in a Recruitment Infraction.
- All Formal Recruitment Plans due at recruitment presentation on Tuesday, November 6th, 2018.
- Philanthropy and Sisterhood videos due by **Monday, November 26th, 2018 by 5pm** via email.Videos/slide shows of pictures should not show pictures of disaffiliates. Final corrections must be submitted via email to the VP of Recruitment by **Tuesday, December 4th, 2018** (study day), **by 5pm.**
- Rho gamma disaffiliation ceremony will be **Monday**, **November 26th**, **2018**. Women are encouraged to keep their affiliation a secret but have the option to tell when asked if they desire once their role as a recruitment guide begins on CPC Day.

December Dates

- The Chapter Recruitment chair will be responsible for completing their chapter budget/expense report for recruitment and turning it into the Office of Fraternity and Sorority Affairs by **Monday**, **December 3rd**, **2018 by 5pm**.
- Final corrections to philanthropy and sisterhood videos must be submitted via email to the VP of Recruitment by **Tuesday, December 4th, 2018** (study day) by 5pm.
- Disaffiliates may attend chapter events until December 18th, 2018 unless there is a Panhellenic event or any event that relates to their role as a recruitment guide which supersedes any chapter event. After December 18th, 2018 disaffiliates may not attend chapter events including but not limited to retreats, ritualistic functions, meetings, and socials. Special permission may be given to disaffiliated sisters who hold officer positions to make appearances at chapter meetings to give reports.

January Dates

- STRICT SILENCE between sorority women and disaffilates begins on **January 7th**, **2019** and last until after new member reveal.
- SILENCE between sorority women and potential new members begins on **January 16th, 2019** and lasts until STRICT SILENCE
- STRICT SILENCE begins at the end of the last round of recruitment (preference) (Sunday, January 20, 2019) until new member reveal, no contact between any affiliated sorority members and potiential new member is permitted.
- Potential new members are required to attend Recruitment Orientation which will be on the day before formal recruitment begins on **January 17th, 2019.**
- Chapters can start setting up on **Thursday, January 17th, 2019** no earlier than 8:00 p.m. and must vacate the building by 11:00 p.m.
- Chapters can reenter their recruitment party site on **Friday**, **January 18th**, **2019** at **8:00** a.m. Refer to the 2019 Official Recruitment Schedule for further time restrictions.
- "Formal Recruitment Weekend" refers to the first day of Formal Recruitment (January 18th, 2019) and lasts until 24 hours after Bid Day (January 21st, 2019).
- First Day Events (Philanthropy Day): Friday, January 18th, 2019 4:00-7:50
- Second Day Events (Fraternal Values Day): Saturday, January 19th, 2019 11:00am-1:00pm LUNCH 1:50pm-3:50pm
- Third Day Events: (Preference) Sunday, January 20th, 2019 10:00am-12:00pm
- Bid Night: Sunday, January 20th, 2019 6:30pm
- Bid Night will be held in the **Richardson Ballroom beginning at 6:30 p.m**. Members of each organization may arrive **beginning at 6 p.m**.
- Total following 2019 Formal Recruitment will be determined no later than 72 hours following bid distribution on **Sunday, January 20th, 2019**.
- Receipts are required to be collected if over \$25. These things could include anything from tables/tablecloth rentals to wall adhesives, poster boards, printed pictures, etc. Receipts and a final budget/expense report will be turned in on **Tuesday January 22th**, **2019** by 5pm. Turning in receipts late will result in a recruitment infraction.
