<p>Reporting to the Central Energy Supervisor, the incumbent operates boilers in the Central Heating Plant and other university locations during heating season and performs repair/ maintenance activities as instructed.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Operates one electrical high-voltage boiler, two gas-and-oil-fired boilers and two gas-fired boilers in the Heating Plant and assists with boilers in other university locations as may be required to ensure safe, efficient and continuous delivery of steam and heat.Monitors boiler operations; immediately reports any abnormalities or problems observed; makes adjustments to boilers or controls as instructed; troubleshoots problems to determine whether an adjustment is needed or there is a system failure; and makes the necessary adjustment or reports the failure.Performs preventive and semi-routine maintenance on boilers and related mechanical equipment, as instructed; performs internal inspections; and assists in preparing boilers for annual inspection and testing.
