Analysis/Interpretation of Winthrop University Students' Performance on the School Psychology Praxis II Exam

Summary:

This was the ninth time in the past ten years that all graduating students passed the School Psychology Praxis Exam (despite the significant changes to the exam as well as the revised pass score set three years ago). As noted below Table 1, the minimum score for national certification is 147, which all test takers exceeded in 2018. These results suggest that students are well prepared to assume their roles upon completion of the School Psychology Program at Winthrop University.



Trends & Additional Interpretations School Psychology Praxis II

The range of total scores was a little wider in 2018, and the median score was slightly lower in 2018, as compared to 2017 – at which time the program attained its highest median score ever. Regression to the mean, however, is a likely reason for this change.

Notably, **the median of 173.5** was still well above the national and state pass score of 147. One candidate earned, what School Psychology faculty believe to be the highest score ever by one of their candidates (191).


The performance of School Psychology candidates on subsections, as compared to data collected in previous years, do not reveal trends. This may be a function of the small sample size and the relatively lower reliability of subsection scores.

Additionally, the two areas in which one test taker in 2018 scored below what the Educational Testing Service (ETS) defines as the average range were different from the areas in which one student scored below average in 2017. Thus, these results do not suggest any trends which appear to warrant attention, although School Psychology faculty are interested in seeing if the increased attention paid to legal and ethical issues in their revised PSYC 615 class (which the 2018 cohort did not have) will result in changes to the scores on "Foundations of School Psychology Service Delivery."



Exercise Science Candidates 29% Passed with a Scaled Score at or Above 70% (70%=Passing) by Test Taker and Year


Scaled Score






Exercise Science Candidates CSCS Practical Exam Subscore on Exercise Technique by Test Taker and Year

Exercise Technique






Exercise Science Candidates CSCS Practical Exam Subscore on Program Design by Test Taker and Year






Exercise Science Candidates CSCS Practical Exam Subscore on Organization and Administration by Test Taker and Year






Exercise Science Candidates CSCS Practical Exam Subscore on Testing and Evaluation by Test Taker and Year






Exercise Science Candidates CSCS Practical Exam Subscores By Test Taker and Year


















Social Work Licensure Exam Eligibility Requirements

Presented in the subsequent graphs and tables are Winthrop University's Social Work Program's students' performance on licensure examinations.

Notably, only students who have met specific eligibility requirement are permitted to sit for these exams.

Eligibility requirements for the graduate level licensure test: Students are permitted to take the exam during their final semester of their MSW program.

Eligibility requirements for the clinical level exam: Students are permitted to take the exam after having earned their MSW degree and after having completed 2-years of supervision by a Licensed Clinical Social Worker.







Interpretation:

These data indicate that not only has Winthrop University (WU) graduate-level Social Work students' performance improved from 2014 to 2017, as per first time test takers' pass rate and the total pass rates, but it has now also exceeded the pass rates for all test takers in North America. Again, caveats in formulating conclusions from these data-- due to the relatively small sample size of WU test takers --are pertinent, but the trends evidenced above are, nonetheless, very positive and indicative of increases in Winthrop's students professional competencies.
