

Using Lockdown Browser and Monitor on a Chromebook

Overview

This tutorial will explain how to **Use LockDown Browser and Monitor on a Chromebook**.

LockDown Browser is a secured browser used solely for taking online exams. When using on a Chromebook, the Lockdown Browser extension must be added to your Chrome browser.

Respondus Monitor, which requires a webcam, can be used in conjunction with the browser to video record the exam.

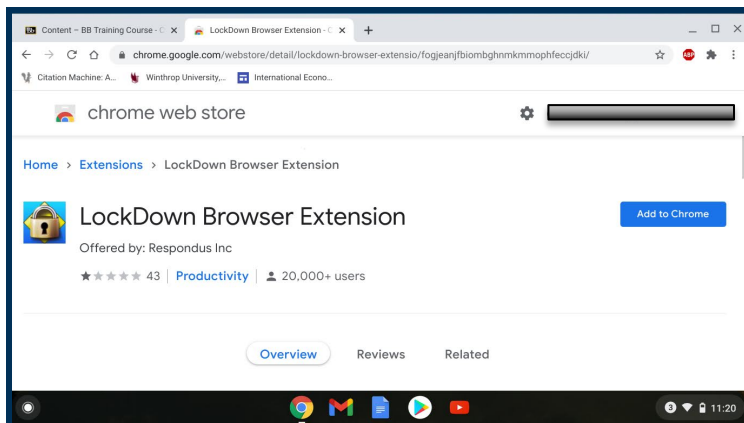
Step 1

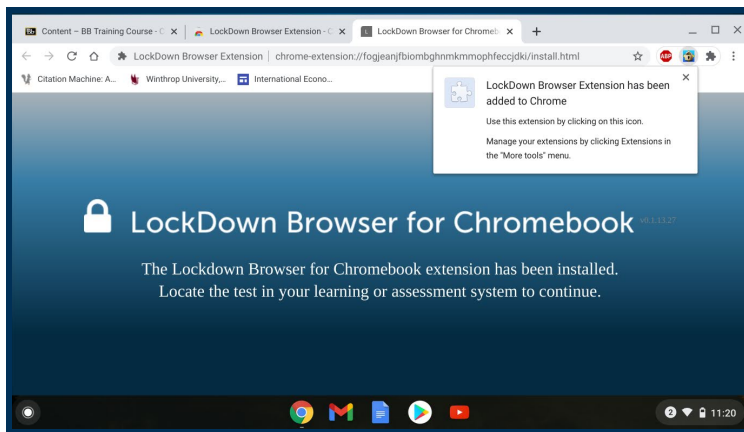
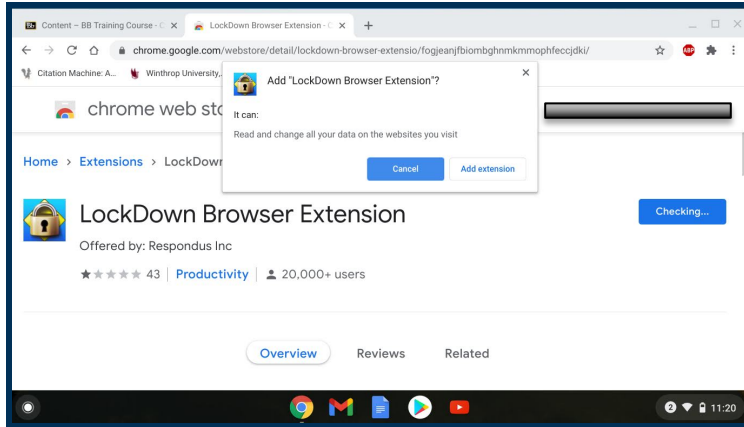
Please watch the short [video](#) to get a basic understanding of LockDown Browser and the optional webcam feature. You may be required to use LockDown Browser with a webcam, which will record you during an online, non-proctored exam. Your computer must have a functioning webcam and microphone.

Step 2

Log into your Chromebook and open the Chrome browser. Click on the download link below. This will automatically redirect you to the Chrome Web Store. Select “Add to Chrome” to install the Lockdown Browser Extension.

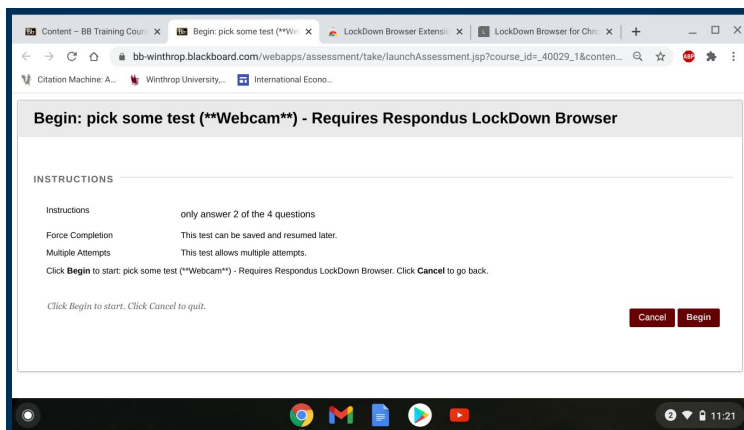

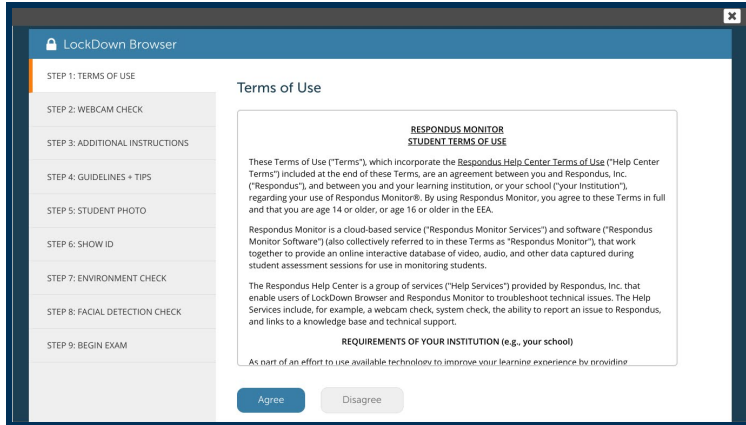




Step 3

In your Chrome browser, log into Blackboard Learn at <https://bb-winthrop.blackboard.com/>. Navigate to your course, and open the exam that requires Lockdown Browser. The Lockdown Browser extension will automatically start when you open the test. You will not be allowed to navigate to any other tabs or programs on the computer until you complete the exam.





Note

Your instructor must use their settings to allow Chromebook usage on an exam. If you are not able to open the exam, contact your instructor first to ensure that they have allowed Chromebook usage in the settings for this exam.
